Thank you for seeking to join the Malta Union of Teachers. In order to finalise the process to become a member, one needs to submit by post or personally the following documents:

- 1** *the filled-in enrolment form;*
- 2** *the equivalent of one year's fee, which is currently set at €45 annually (note: please do not send cash by post);*
- 3** *the SEPA Direct Debit Mandate which will enable automatic membership renewal for the subsequent years. The fee collection through SEPA is usually made every January. More info at MUT.ORG.MT.*

N.B. This form has to be submitted to the MUT and not to the bank.

Please note that membership requests will only be raised to the MUT Council for approval once all documents, including the SEPA Direct Debit Mandate, have been submitted.

What happens next?

- Once approved by the MUT Council, members will receive a printed receipt together with the MUT membership card (including allocated number) by post.
- With their membership number, members can then create a password and log in to the MUT website to access Members Area information, view/update their personal details, receipts and/or request a full statement. Instructions can be found at MUT.ORG.MT.
- Once confirmed, members can then have access to all membership services including information and updates by the MUT, advice and assistance services, participation and representation including agreements and ongoing discussions with employers, and other services.
