# MASTER OF ARTS IN CATHOLIC SCHOOL LEADERSHIP

#### **COMMENCING OCTOBER 2023**

In October 2023, the Faculty of Theology at the University of Malta will once again be offering the Master of Arts in Catholic School Leadership course. The Master of Arts in Catholic School Leadership is recommended for those interested or are already involved in the running of Catholic schools or schools with a Catholic Vision or Ethos, and those interested in enriching their profession with the philosophical vision of Catholic leadership.

Offered now every two years, this professional programme is intended to train and empower candidates involved in the leadership of schools and other faith entities. It aims at fostering research and good practices in managerial and leadership skills, as well as reflective practice in Catholic leadership.

The course is spread over six semesters and entails two years of lectures and one year solely

dedicated to research and the writing of a dissertation with no lectures. It is offered on a part-time basis (2 evenings every week and some seminars) and covers the following modules:

#### **First Year**

Studies in Educational Management and Leadership
Fundamentals of Educational Research
Applied Educational Research Methods
Professional Development Models
Critical Issues for School Leaders or Effective Leadership in Schools

### **Second Year**

Catholic Understanding of Humanity for Contemporary Culture Leadership in the Church Psychology of Leadership Nurturing Professional Learning Communities in Maltese Schools Contemporary Catholic Institutions: Implications for Leadership Developing Emotional and Relational Competence **or** Study Visit

# **Third Year**

Dissertation

A more detailed course outline is attached. This has links to the study-unit descriptions.

It is noteworthy to keep in mind that this course has been recognised as comparable to other recognised Master in Educational Leadership for the Post of Head of School in any type of school. See the attached document.
