The European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions (Eurofound) is carrying out the eighth edition of its European Working Conditions Survey from February to May 2024. In cooperation with the independent market research company, **misco** International, Eurofound will be interviewing approximately 50,000 workers in all EU Member States and a number of other European countries about different aspects of their working life, such as working time, work organisation, work-life balance and work-related health issues. Data will be collected through face to face surveys carried out across households all over Malta and Gozo.

By taking part respondents will help to improve the quality of employment for all workers in Malta and across Europe. All answers will provide the evidence base for the betterment of policies dedicated to improving working conditions and the quality of employment for all workers.
